


Backlink Factors



87. Linking Domain Age: Backlinks from aged domains may be more powerful than new domains.

88. # of Linking Root Domains: The number of referring domains is one of the most important ranking factors in Google's algorithm, as you can see from this industry study of 1 million Google Search results.



89. # of Links from Separate C-Class IPs: Links from separate class-c IP addresses suggest a wider breadth of sites linking to you, which can help with rankings.





Creation Tips



Intro is king! Write like a journalist!

Intro paragraph is crucial – this needs to be your entire storey in less than 30 words!

The **topline** is your **most crucial** piece of information.

- 2. Summarise & cover your main point
- 3. Avoid repetition of the intro
- 4. Ask yourself, what will encourage clicks?

Where you can add colour & bring your client to the story. Have information that adds & compliments the story.



A spokesperson from <u>CE Safety</u> says: "Our advice is to remove alcohol-based hand sanitisers when the British public leave their cars.

"If it is 25°C outside, the estimated vehicle interior air temperature can reach up to 50°C if left for a couple of hours. So, it is no surprise to see pictures circulating on social media showing severely damaged vehicles due to hand sanitiser bottles that had ignited inside a vehicle sitting in direct sunlight."



1 sentence paragraphs

Have white space to break

up the text & it will be

- 1. Easier to follow
- 2. Easier to edit
- 3. Easier to cut

With a heatwave expected in the UK, experts at <u>CE Safety</u> are alerting Brits to the potential fire risk in vehicles caused by alcohol-based hand sanitisers.

With the weather getting warmer, rising temperatures can cause the alcohol in the sanitiser to evaporate, and this can result in flammable vapours being released.

Use emotive language

You want the journalist to publish the story, but also make their readers feel something.

Use emotional trigger words such as...

Warning! Discover! Revealed!
